Orange beanie

Size: one (for Woman Head)

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 1 ball (50g and 90m) of Maxi Soft yarn (100% Extrafine Merino Wool) shade no. 14472

Hook: A 4.50mm

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using hook: Chain (ch) - Slip stitch (ss) - Double crochet (dc) - Half treble (htr) - Tr (treble) - Double treble (dtr) - Front post double treble (FPdtr) - Front post 2 dtr joined together (FPdtr2tog)

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 44cm approx - Width: 20cm approx

INSTRUCTIONS

Round 1: working into a magic loop, (1 dc, 5 tr) 4 times, join with ss to first dc. (There are 4 5-tr shells and 4 dc). **NOTE:** Your piece will take on a square appearance after completing this round. Don't be alarmed- this beanie will change shape many times over the course of the next few rounds, and will not start to look circular until finishing a couple rounds with no increases. **Round 2:** ss over 2 sts to top of first shell, ch 1, * 1 dc in next st (this will be the 3rd stitch of your 5-tr shell), miss 2 sts, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in next dc, miss 2 sts; repeat from * around, join with ss to first dc. (There are 4 split shells and 4 dc). **Round 3:** ss over 1 st, ch 1, * 1 dc in next st (this will be the center st of split shell), miss 1 st, 5 tr in ch-1 sp, miss 1 st, 1 dc in next st, miss 1 st, 5 tr in next dc, miss 1 st; repeat from * around, join with ss to first dc (There are 8 5-tr shells and 8 dc). **Round 4:** ss over 2 sts to top of first shell, ch 1, * 1 dc in next st, miss 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, miss 2 sts; repeat from * around, join with ss to first dc (There are 8 shells and 8 dc). **Round 5:** ss over 2 sts to top of first shell, ch 1, * 1 dc in next st (this will be the 3rd stitch of your 5-tr shell), miss 2 sts, work (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in dc, miss 2 sts, 1 dc in next st, miss 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, miss 2 sts; repeat from * around, join with ss to first dc. **Round 6:** ss over 1 st, ch 1, * 1 dc in next st (this will be the center st of split shell), miss next st, 5 tr in ch-1 sp, miss next st, 1 dc in next st, miss next st, 5 tr in next st, miss 2 sts, 1 dc in next st, miss 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, miss next st; repeat from * around, join with ss to first dc (12 5-tr shells). **Rounds 7-10:** sl st over 2 sts to top of first shell, ch 1, * 1 dc in next st, miss 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, miss 2 sts; repeat from * around,

join with ss to first dc (12 5-tr shells). **Round 11:** ch 1, 1 htr in each st around, join with ss to first htr. (There are 72 htr) **Round 12:** ch 1, working all sts of round in centre post of htr, 1 dc in each st around, join with ss to first dc. **Round 13:** ch 1, 1 tr in each st around, join with ss to first tr (There are 72 tr). **Round 14:** ch 1, FPdtr around the 2nd dc of round 12, work 1 dc in each of next 3 sts, FPdtr2tog, placing first st around same dc in round 12 that you just worked the first FPdtr around, move forward 3 sts in round 12 and place second st of the FPdtr2tog around the 4th dc, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts of previous round, *FPdtr2tog, placing first st around same dc in round 12 that you put the last st of the previous FPdtr2tog, skip forward 3 sts in round 12, and place second st of the FPdtr2tog around the 4th dc, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts of previous round; repeat from * across but, when you get to the last stitch in your round, FPdtr around the last FPdtr-2tog st you made, before you finish the FPdtr, when there are 2 loops left on your hook, insert hook into last st of round, yarn over hook, and pull through all remaining loops, join with ss to first FPdtr (There are 72 sts). **Round 15:** ch 1, 1 tr in each st around, join with sl st to first tr (There are 72 tr). **Round 16:** ch 1, 1 dc in same st as join, 1 dc in next st, FPdtr2tog, placing first st around the top of the first and last FPdtr in round 14 (this will pull them together to look like they are one stitch), put the second st around the next FPdtr2tog from round 14; * 1 dc in each of the next 3 sts, FPdtr2tog placing first st around the top of the FPdtr2tog in round 14 that you just came off of, place the second st of the FPdtr2tog around the next FPdtr2tog from round 14; repeat from * around. (**Note:** The final st of the final FPdtr2tog will be worked around the same stitches as the first st of the first FPdtr2tog in the round), 1 dc in last st of round, join with ss to first dc (There are 72 sts). **Round 17:** ch 1, 1 tr in same st as join and in each st around, join with ss to first tr (There are 72 tr). **Round 18:** ch 1, FPdtr around next post stitch of round 16, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts; then work FPdtr-2tog, placing first st around same post stitch in round 16 that you just did the first FPdtr around, move forward 3 stitches in round 16 and place second st of the FPdtr2tog around the next post stitch, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts of current round, *FPdtr2tog, placing first st around same post stitch in round 16 that you put the last st of the previous FPdtr2tog, skip forward 3 sts in round 16, and place second st of the FPdtr2tog around the next post stitch, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts of current round; repeat from * around, when you get to the last

stitch in your round, FPdtr around the last FPdtr-2tog st you made, before you finish the FPdtr, when there are 2 loops left on your hook, insert hook through that last stitch, yarn over hook, and pull up a loop, insert your hook under the first FPdtr, and then pull that loop through all remaining loops. This will join the round (There are 72 sts). **Round 19:** ch 1, 1 htr in each st around, join with ss to first htr. (There are 72 sts) **Round 20:** ch 1, working all sts of round in centre post of htr, 1 dc in each st around, join with ss to first dc (There are 72 sts). Fasten off. **Note:** wash beanie carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the beanie to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.

Fuchsia hairband

Size: one (for Woman Head) - **Skill Level:** easy

How much yarn: 1 ball (50g and 90m) of Maxi Soft yarn (100% Extrafine Merino Wool) shade no. A3088

Hook: A 4.50mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using hook: Chain (ch) - Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) - Treble (tr).

FRONT POST DOUBLE TREBLE (FPDTR): instead of crocheting into the top of a stitch, you crochet around the post of the stitch, inserting the hook between two stitches from front to back, then around back through the front; yarn over and draw up a loop, (yarn over and pull through 2 loops) 4 times, to complete the stitch.

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 52cm approx - Width: 8cm approx

INSTRUCTIONS

With 4.50mm hook ch72, join with a ss to form a ring. **Round 1:** ch1, 1 dc into each foundation ch; end with a ss into first dc. **Round 2:** ch3 (corresponding to first treble), 1 tr into each dc; end with a ss into 3rd of first 3 ch. **Round 3:** ch3 (corresponding to first treble), * 1 FPdtr around next tr; 1 tr into next tr; rep from * ending with 1 tr into last tr and 1 ss into 3rd of first 3 ch. **Round 4:** ch3 (corresponding to first treble), * 1 tr into next tr; 1 FPdtr around next tr; rep from * ending with 1 tr into last tr and 1 ss into 3rd of first 3 ch. **Rounds 5-8:** rep 2 times Rounds 3 and 4. **Round 9:** ch1, 1 dc into each foundation ch; end with a ss into first dc. Fasten off. With yarn needle, weave in ends.

Note: wash hairband carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the hairband to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.

Yellow hairband

Size: one (for Woman Head) - **Skill Level:** easy

How much yarn: 1 ball (50g and 90m) of Maxi Soft yarn (100% Extrafine Merino Wool) shade no. A1787

Needles: A pair of 5.00mm needles

A double-pointed (Dp) cable needle

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: garter stitch (g st)

DOUBLE CABLE PATTERN: (work over 12 stitches)

1st row: P1, K4, P2, K4, P1. **2nd and following even rows:** Knit the K stitches and purl the P stitches. **3rd row:** as 1st row. **5th row:** P1, 4 Left crossed stitches (= place next 2 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 2 sts, K2 from Dp needle), P2, 4 Left crossed stitches, P1. **7th row:** as 1st row. **8th row:** K1, P4, K2, P4, K1. Rep from 1st to 8th row throughout.

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 50cm approx - Width: 8cm approx

INSTRUCTIONS

With 5.00mm needles cast on 20 sts and work as follows: work first and last 4 sts in g st and centre 12 sts in Double cable pattern. When hairband measures 50cm from beg (or it is long as you desire), cast off all sts. With yarn needle join cast-on and cast-off stitches sewing side seam to form a ring. **Note:** wash hairband carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the hairband to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.
