EVEREST p. 7

Three cushion covers

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: 19 balls (50g and 50m) of Natura yarn (40% Merino Extrafine Wool, 35% Cotton, 25% Baby Alpaca) whose 7 balls in off white no. 30218, 5 balls in cream no. 30219 and 7 balls in pink no. 30220

Needles: A pair of 8.00mm knitting needles
A cable needle

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: three cushion pad to measurements

STITCHES

Using needles: stocking stitch (st st) - Reverse stocking stitch (rev st st) - CABLE: (worked over 6 sts)
1st row: K6. **2nd row and even following rows:** P6.
3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, and 11th rows: K6. **13th row:** C6F (= slip 3 sts onto cable needle, hold to the front, K3sts, K3sts from cable needle). **14th row:** P6. Rep from 1st to 14th row throughout.

INSTRUCTIONS LARGE CUSHION (58x50cm)

Cover panel: with off white no. 30218 yarn and 8mm needles cast on 64 sts and work as follows: 20 sts in stocking st, 20 sts in rev st st, (6 sts Cable, 1 st in rev st st) twice, 6 sts Cable, 2 sts in rev st st, 20 sts in stocking st. When work measures 100cm from beg, cast off all sts.

Finishing: fold panel in half, RS facing RS, sew two side seams (RH vertical side and LH vertical side), excluding horizontal side. Reverse work on RS, insert cushion pad and sew open side.

INSTRUCTIONS SMALL CUSHION (48x40cm)

Cover panel: with cream no. 30219 yarn and 8mm needles cast on 50 sts and work as follows: 13 sts in stocking st, 2 sts in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 1 st in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 2 sts in rev st st, 20 sts in stocking st. When work measures 80cm from beg, cast off all sts. **Finishing:** as Large Cushion.

INSTRUCTIONS RECTANGULAR CUSHION (60x38cm)

Cover panel: with pink no. 30220 yarn and 8mm needles cast on 72 sts and work as follows: 9 sts in st st, 2 sts in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 1 st in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 2 sts in rev st st, 20 sts in stocking st, 2 sts in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 1 st in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 2 sts in rev st st, 9 sts in stocking st. When work measures 76cm from beg, cast off all sts. **Finishing:** as Large Cushion. If you prefer, don't sew last open side and put a zip fastener.

Blanket

Size: each square 18x18cm

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 6 balls (50g and 50m) of Natura yarn (40% Merino Extrafine Wool, 35% Cotton, 25% Baby Alpaca) in off white no. 30218, in cream no. 30219, in pink no. 30220, and in brown no. 30221

Needles: A pair of 8.00mm knitting needles

Hook: A 7.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: garter stitch (g st)

Using hook: double crochet (dc)

INSTRUCTIONS

The blanket is composed of 8 rows, each made up of 8 Motifs.

1st ROW - 1st SQUARE: with pink yarn and 8.00mm knitting needles cast on 33 sts and work as follows: **1st row:** K15, K3tog, K15. **2nd row:** K. Rep these 2 rows throughout until 3 sts remain. K3tog. Cut yarn and fasten off.

2nd SQUARE: with WS facing, off white yarn and 8.00mm knitting needles pick up and K17 sts across upper side on 1st Square (dec slanting line on RS must go towards left hand side) and cast on 16 new sts. There are 33 sts. Work as 1st Square. Continue as given for 2nd Square and work other 6 Squares, following that colour sequence: brown, cream, pink, off white, brown, cream.

2nd ROW - Work as given for 1st row Squares, following that colour sequence: off white, brown, cream, pink, off white, brown, cream, pink.

3rd ROW - Work as given for 1st row Squares, following that colour sequence: brown, cream, pink, off white, brown, cream, pink, off white.

4th ROW - Work as given for 1st row Squares, following that colour sequence: cream, pink, off white, brown, cream, pink, off white, brown.

5th ROW - Work as given for 1st row.

6th ROW - Work as given for 2nd row.

7th ROW - Work as given for 3rd row.

8th ROW - Work as given for 4th row.

Finishing: with yarn needle join the eight rows on WS, following this row sequence given. With crochet hook and off white yarn, work a round of dc all around Blanket. Fasten off.

Pocket emptier

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 5 balls (each ball 50g and 100m) of Everest yarn (95% Merino Wool, 5% Viscose) shade no. 10105

Hook: A 5.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: Snap fasteners. Stiffener

STITCHES

Using hook: chain (ch) - Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) - Treble (tr)

INSTRUCTIONS (34x34cm)

Create a magic ring and into ring work:

1st round: * 3 tr (work ch3 instead of first tr throughout), 2 ch; rep from * 4 times ending with a ss into first tr. **2nd round:** * 1 tr into each of next 3 tr, (2 tr, ch2, 2 tr) into next ch2-space; rep from * 4 times ending with a ss into first tr. **3rd round:** 1 tr into each of next 5 tr, (2 tr, ch2, 2 tr) into next ch2-space, * 1 tr into each of next 7 tr, (2 tr, ch2, 2 tr) into next ch2-space; rep from * 3 times ending with 1 tr into each of last 2 tr and a ss into first tr. **4th round:** 1 tr into each of next 7 tr, (2 tr, ch2, 2 tr) into next ch2-space, * 1 tr into each of next 11 tr, (2 tr, ch2, 2 tr) into next ch2-space; rep from * 3 times ending with 1 tr into each of last 4 tr and a ss into first tr. **5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th rounds:** work as given, increasing trebles each round among corner spaces. **9th round:** 1 dc into each tr of previous round and 2 dc in each ch2-space. **10th and 11th rounds:** work 1 tr into each st of previous round. Fasten off.

Finishing: sew snaps at each corner, over last 2 rounds. Spread the stiffener on all piece, then fold up last 2 rounds and fasten snaps. It is possible to work a larger or smaller piece, working more or less rounds before dc round.

Glove box

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 5 balls (each ball 50g and 100m) of Everest yarn (95% Merino Wool, 5% Viscose) shade no. 14574

Needles: A pair of 5.00mm knitting needles
A cable needle

Hook: A 4.50mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: K2, P2 rib.

CABLE STITCH: (worked over a multiple of 14 sts)

1st row: * P4, K6, P4; rep from * 3 more times. **2nd row and even following rows:** Knit the K sts and purl the P sts. **3rd and 5th rows:** work as 1st row. **7th row:** * P4, C6F (slip 3 sts onto cable needle, hold to the front, K3sts, K3sts from cable needle), P4; rep from * 3 more times. **9th and 11th rows:** work as 1st row. **12th row:** work as 2nd row. Rep from 1st to 12th row throughout.

Using hook: double crochet (dc)

INSTRUCTIONS (30x62cm)

Panel: with 5.00mm needles cast on 56 sts and, for lower edge, work 4 rows in K2, P2 rib. Cont to work in Cable stitch until work measures 62cm from beg. Cast off. **Pocket:** with RS facing and 5.00mm needles pick up and K 56 sts across 4th row of rib edge and work in Cable stitch until work measures 12cm from beg. Cast off. **Finishing:** with 4.50mm hook work a row of dc along each vertical side, inserting hook at the same time into corresponding sts of pocket and panel, to join in this manner pocket to panel. Then work also a row of dc along upper side of panel. With sewing needle work a row of back stitch between cables (at centre of rev st st sts), inserting needle at the same time into corresponding sts of pocket and panel, to divide large pocket and create 4 small pockets.
