



Bangle

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: 1 balls (50g and 125m) of Milo yarn (100% Cotton) shade no. 8686
1 balls (25g and 195m) of Paillettes yarn (100% Polyester) shade no. 8933

Hook: A 2.00mm crochet hook

A 3.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using hook: chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Treble (tr)

FRONT POST TREBLE (FPTR): yarn on hook, insert hook around stem of treble from front to back, yarn on hook and pull through a loop, (yarn on hook and pull through two loops on hook) twice

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: work with a strand of Milo yarn and a strand of Paillettes yarn held together throughout. With 3.00mm crochet hook, ch45 and join in a ring with a ss into first ch, then work as follows: **1st round:** ch2, 1 tr into each of next 44 ch, change hook and with 2.00 crochet hook end with a ss into 2nd of first ch2. From **2nd to 5th round:** with 3.00mm crochet hook widen the loop on hook slightly and cont to work 1 FPTR in each st of previous round and, at end of the round, with 2.00 crochet hook work 1 ss inserting hook into first st of this round and, at the same time, into first st of previous round to create a hidden closure. At end of 5th round, turn bangle on wrongside and join last round to opposite side of first round, working 1 ss inserting hook at the same time into a stitch of previous round and into corresponding st across starting ch. At end, fasten off. Cut yarn and weave it among stitches to hide. Shape the finished bangle with your hands.

Dangle earrings

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: 1 balls (50g and 125m) of Milo yarn (100% Cotton) shade no. 8686.
1 balls (25g and 195m) of Paillettes yarn (100% Polyester) shade no. 8933

Hook: A 2.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: Two earring hooks

Sewing needle and matching thread

STITCHES

Using hook: chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc)

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: work with a strand of Milo yarn and a strand of Paillettes yarn held together throughout. For each earring, with 2.00mm crochet hook, ch4, 1 ss into 2nd ch from hook, 1 ss into each of next 2 ch, then ch7, 1 ss into 2nd ch from hook and 1 ss into each of next 5 ch, then ch4, 1 ss into 2nd ch from hook, 1 ss into each of rem 2 ch, end with a ss into next st. For oval ring, ch9, 1 ss into st at base of ch9 just made, ch1, 9 dc into ring, a ss at base of ring. Fasten off. Cut yarn and weave it among stitches to hide. With sewing needle join thread at centre of oval ring, insert an earring hook, then insert thread fasten off on wrongside.
