A-Line Dress

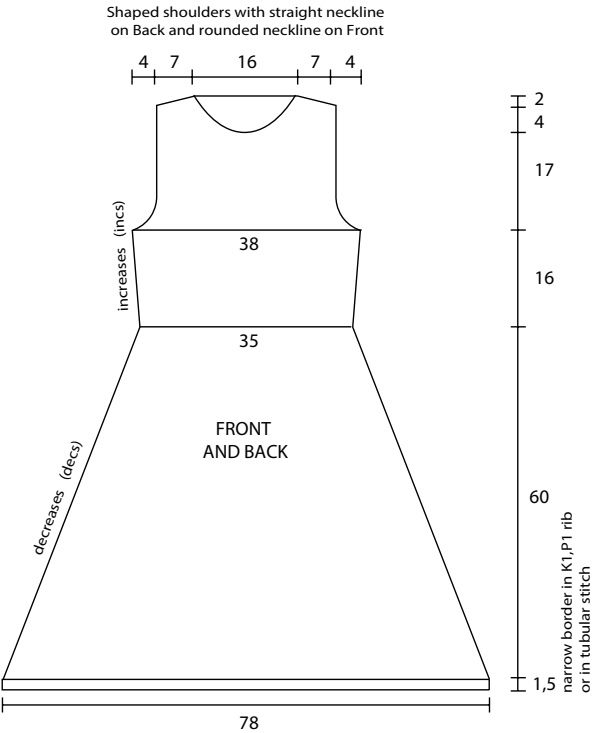
Size: UK 10 – US 6 – EU 36
Skill Level: intermediate
How much yarn: 12 balls (each ball 25g and 130m) of Melodia yarn (55% Polyamide, 45% Polyeste) shade no. 30875
Needles: A par of 2.75 mm knitting needles
Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES
Using needles: K1, P1 rib (or tubular stitch) – Stocking stitch (st st) – Reverse stocking stitch (rev st st)

Note: before starting work prepare a sample in stocking stitch (15x15cm), then based on this calculate the stitches and rows needed to obtain the indicated or desired measurements.

INSTRUCTIONS
Back: following measurements and notes indicated on dress template, work Back, starting with a narrow border in K1, P1 rib or in tubular st. Cont to work in rev stocking st, shaping sides, armholes and shoulders.
Front: following measurements and notes indicated on dress template, work as Back, decreasing to create the rounded neck-shape.

FINISHING
Sew shoulder and side seams. Finish neck-edge and each armhole with a narrow band in stocking st and sew it on WS of work.



Close-fitting Dress

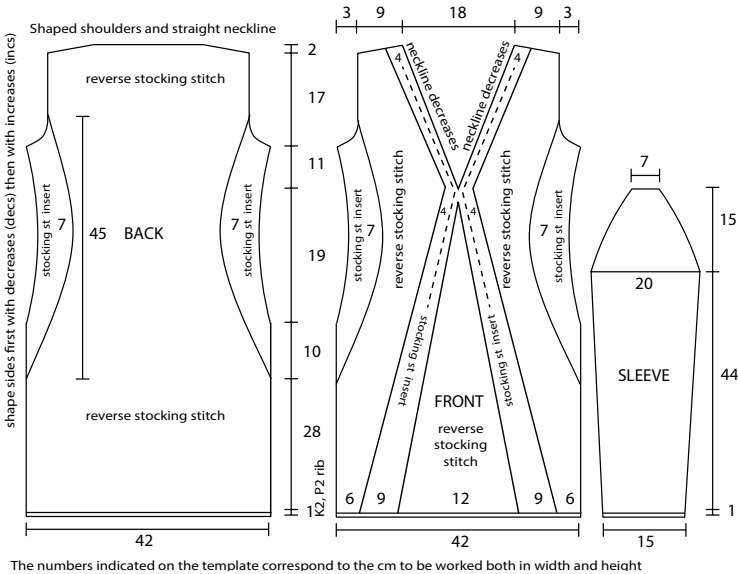
Size: UK 10 – US 6 – EU 36 – **Skill Level:** intermediate
How much yarn: 25 balls (each ball 25g and 112m) of Deco yarn (55% Polyamide, 45% Polyester) shade no. 30909
Needles: A par of 2.75 mm knitting needles
Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES
Using needles: K2, P2 rib – Stocking stitch (st st) Reverse stocking stitch (rev st st)

Note: before starting work prepare a sample in stocking stitch (15x15cm), then based on this calculate the stitches and rows needed to obtain the indicated or desired measurements.

INSTRUCTIONS
Back: following measurements and notes indicated on dress template, work Back, starting with a narrow border in K2, P2 rib. Cont to work in rev stocking st, shaping sides, armholes and shoulders. At the same time work the inserts in stocking stitch along the sides where indicated.
Front: following measurements and notes indicated on dress template, work as Back, decreasing to create the deep V-neck. At the same time alternate the stocking stitch with the reverse stocking stitch, to create the different working bands.
Sleeves: (make 2) following measurements and notes indicated on relative template, work each sleeve, starting with a narrow border in K2, P2 rib. Cont to work in rev stocking st, shaping sleeve top.

FINISHING
Sew shoulder seams, then work a narrow border in



K2, P2 rib around neckline, starting and ending at base of V-neck, then join it with a seam. Sew dress side seams. Sew sleeve seams, then set in sleeves.

V-neck Sweater

Size: UK 10 – US 6 – EU 36 – **Skill Level:** intermediate
How much yarn: 8 balls (each ball 50g and 110m) of Soffio yarn (44% Polyester, 19% Polyamide, 19% Alpaca, 18% Wool) shade no. 30886
Needles: A par of 5.00 mm knitting needles
Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES
Using needles: K1, P1 rib – Tubular stitch Stocking stitch (st st)

TENSION (after work has been steamed)
16.5 sts and 21 rows measure 10cm square over stocking st with 5.00 mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS
Back: cast on 77 sts and, for lower border, work 4 rows in tubular st and cont in K1, P1 rib, starting and ending with P1, until border measures 10 cm from beg. Cont to work in st st, increasing 1 st (= K1 and K1 through back loop of same st) at each end, inside 4 sts, on 11th row and every following 8th row 4 times: there are 85 sts. When work measures 28cm from beg, shape armholes: cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows: 79 sts rem. **Next row (RS):** K3, K2tog, K to last 5 sts, SKIP (= slip 1 st, knit 1 st, pass slipped st over K1), K3. **Next row:** P. Rep last 2 rows 6 more times: 65 sts rem. When armhole measures 20cm, shape shoulders, dec 1 st at each end, inside first and last 3 sts, every row 5 times, (work 1 row without decs, then dec 1 st at each end, as before, 3 times) 3 times. Cast off rem 37 sts.
Front: work as Back, until work measures 33cm from beg. Shape V-neck: cast off centre st, join another ball of yarn and cont separately on either side, dec 1 st at neck edge, inside 3 sts, on next and every alternate row 15 times, then every following 4th row 4 times. AT THE SAME TIME as 15th neck dec, inc 1 st on outer side, inside 4 sts, and rep this inc every following 4th row 4 more times. After 4 rows from last inc, shape shoulders: for either side cast off 9 sts on next and alternate row.

Sleeves: for each sleeve, cast on 43 sts and, for cuff, work 4 rows in tubular st and cont in K1, P1 rib, starting and ending with P1, until work measures 7 cm from beg. Cont to work in st st, increasing 1 st at each end, inside first and last 2 sts, on next and every following

8th row 9 times. There are 61 sts. When sleeve measures 50cm from beg, shape top. Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end, inside first and last 3 sts, on next and every alternate row 4 times, then every following 4th row 4 times, every alternate row 4 times and every row 6 times. When sleeve top measures 19cm, cast off rem 17 sts.

FINISHING
Sew shoulder seams. **Neck border:** cast on 139 sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st and cont in K1, P1 rib, starting and ending with P1, until border measures 5 cm from beg. Cast off. Sew border around neck-edge, starting and ending at base of the V-neckline and overlapping right end to left end, as shown in picture. Set in sleeves, then sew sleeve and side seams.

Bright effect Jumper

Size: UK 10 – US 6 – EU 36
Skill Level: intermediate due to the model shape – advanced due to the yarn structure

How much yarn: 7 balls (each ball 50g and 200m) of Scintilla yarn (55% Viscose, 24% Metallized Polyester, 21% Polyamide) shade no. 30957
Needles: A par of 4.00 mm knitting needles
Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES
Using needles: Garter stitch (g st) Stocking stitch (st st)

TENSION
27 sts measure 10cm in width over stocking st with 4.00 mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS
Back: cast on 114 sts and, for lower border, work 2cm in garter st. Continue in st st, until work measures 46cm from beg, then cast off. **Front:** work as Back.
Sleeves: for each sleeve, cast on 108 sts and, for cuff, work 2cm in garter st. Continue in st st, dec 1 st at each end on next and every following 6th row 7 times: 94 sts remain. Cont to work in st st for 48cm, then cast off.

FINISHING
Sew shoulder seams (approx 6cm each shoulder), set in sleeves, then sew sleeve and side seams.
NOTE: wash all items carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the items to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.
