



Size: UK 8/10 (12/14)

US 4/6 (8/10)

EU 34/36 (38/40)

Note: figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn:

6 (8) balls (each

ball 50g and 90m)

of **Wool Mohair** yarn

(73% Mohair, 27% Wool) shade no. 14044

Needles: A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles

A pair of 5.50mm knitting needles

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: Four buttons

STITCHES

Using needles: K2, P2 rib - Stocking stitch (st st)

TENSION

13 sts and 18 rows measure 10cm square over stocking stitch with 5.50 mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with 5.50mm knitting needles cast on 66 (70) sts and, for border, work 14 rows K2, P2 rib. Cont in st st. When work measures 25(27)cm from beg, shape armholes, by casting off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then, for raglans, dec 1 st at each end, inside first and last st, on next and every alternate row 20 (21) times. When armhole measures 23(25)cm, cast off rem 22 (24)sts for neck-edge.

Right Front: with 5.50mm knitting needles cast on 31 (33) sts and, for border, work 14 rows K2, P2 rib, inc 2 sts evenly across last row. There are 33 (35) sts. Cont in st st. When work measures 25(27)cm from beg, shape armhole: casting off 2 sts on LH (left hand) side, then for raglan dec on same LH side: 1 st inside 1 st on next and every following alternate row 20 (21) times. AT THE SAME TIME, shape neck on RH (right hand) side: dec 1 st inside

1 st on next and every following 4th row 10 (11) times. When armhole measures 23(25)cm, cast off rem stitch.

Left Front: work as Right Front reversing shapings.

Sleeves: with 5.50mm knitting needles cast on 42 (44) sts and, for cuff, work 18 rows K2, P2 rib. Cont in st st, inc 1 st at each end, inside first and last 2 sts, on next and every following 12th (10th) row 5 (7) times. There are 52 (58) sts. When work measures 48(50)cm from beg, shape top, by casting off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then, for raglans, dec 1 st at each end, inside first and last st, on next and every alternate row 18 (21) times, then on following 4th row once (0 times). When top shaping measures 23(25)cm, cast off rem 10 (12) sts.

FINISHING

Sew raglan and sew side and sleeve seams.

Opening and neck border: with 4.00mm needles and RS facing pick up and K 214 (224) sts along Front openings and Back neck-edge and work in K2, P2 rib. Open 4 buttonholes (cast off 2 sts for each buttonhole and cast on them again on next row) in correspondence with Right Front: the first 3.5cm from bottom and the other three 10 (12) sts evenly spaced. When 12 rows have been worked, cast off all sts knit-ways. Sew buttons on Left Front, in correspondence with buttonholes.

Note: wash garment carefully at low temperature, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the garment to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging them.
