



One size: for women
Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 2 balls (each ball 100g and 110m) of **Banana** yarn (50% Recycled Cotton, 50% Recycled Polyester) shade no. 31219

Hook: A 4.50mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: A stitch marker

STITCHES

Using crochet hook: chain (ch) - Double crochet (dc) Half Treble (htr). RIDGE HALF TREBLE FRONT (RHTRF): work 1 htr inserting hook into front loop only of previous row.

TENSION

15 stitches and 11 rounds measure 10cm square over half trebles using 4.50mm hook. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Work beanie hat in spiral way, working the rounds continuously but without joining each round with a slip stitch, as the round continuing into the next round. Place 1 SM (= stitch marker) into first st of each round

to indicate beginning and move SM every round. Make a magic ring. Into this ring work as follows: **1st round:** 10 dc; pull yarn to close magic ring. **2nd round:** 2 htr into each st of previous round (= 20 htr). **3rd round:** * 1 htr into next htr, 2 htr (= 1 increase) into next htr; rep from * 9 more times (= 30 htr). **4th round:** * 1 htr into each of following 2 htr, 2 htr (= 1 increase) into next htr; rep from * 9 more times (= 40 htr). **5th round:** * 1 htr into each of following 3 htr, 2 htr (= 1 increase) into next htr; rep from * 9 more times (= 50 htr). **6th round:** * 1 htr into each of following 4 htr, 2 htr (= 1 increase) into next htr; rep from * 9 more times (= 60 htr). From **7th to 11th round:** work 1 htr into each htr (= 60 htr). **12th round:** (1 htr into each of next 14 htr, 2 htr into following htr) 4 times (= 64 htr). **13th and 14th round:** work a round of htr, increasing sts above increases of previous round (= 72 htr). **15th round:** (1 htr into each of next 17 htr, 2 htr into following htr) 4 times (= 76 htr). **16th round:** work 1 htr into each htr (= 76 htr). **Note:** on next round work in Ridge half treble Front. **17th round:** (1 RhtrF into each of next 18 htr, 2 RhtrF into following htr) 4 times (= 80 RhtrF). **18th round:** (1 htr into each of next 19 RhtrF, 2 htr into following RhtrF) 4 times (= 84 htr). **19th round:** (1 htr into each of next 20 htr, 2 htr into following htr) 4 times (= 88 htr). **20th round:** (1 htr into each of next 21 htr, 2 htr into following htr) 4 times (= 92 htr). **21st and 22nd round:** work 1 htr into each htr (= 92 htr). Fasten off. Cut yarn and weave in ends. Fold on Right Side last rounds, as shown in picture.

MINI CLUTCH BANANA



Measurements: approx 25x18cm, includine closure
Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 2 balls (each ball 100g and 110m)

of **Banana** yarn (50% Recycled Cotton, 50% Recycled Polyester) shade no. 31219

Hook: A 4.50mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point
Other items: A 22cm clutch metallic closure

STITCHES

Using crochet hook: chain (ch) - Double crochet (dc)

TENSION

15 stitches and 14 rounds of dc measure 10cm square using 4.50mm hook. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Start with a number of chains equal to the internal measurement of the chosen closure: 22cm for the clutch in the picture. **Note:** to take the measurements correctly, keep the closure open. Then work a round of dc all around starting ch, working 3 dc into first and last ch on 1st round. On following rounds make these same increases above increases of previous round until the base measures 8cm in total width. Work other 20 rounds of dc without increasing. With same yarn, cover the closure, then join it to bag working a round of dc. Cut and secure the yarn.
