



Measurements Beanie:

one size for women

Measurements Scarf:

approx 23x172cm

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: 1 ball
(each ball 333g and 333m)
of **Ice Skating** yarn
(100% Wool) shade
no. 31442

Needles: A pair of
9.00mm needles

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: K1, P1 rib – Stocking stitch (st st)
Garter stitch (g st)

TENSION

11 stitches and 15 rows measure 10cm square over stocking st using 9.00 mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS BEANIE

With 9mm needles cast on 55 sts and, for border, work 6 rows K1, P1 rib, corresponding to 4cm, and cont in st st increasing on first row (RS of work) 1 st into 2nd st and another st into last-but-one st. For increasing, work K1 and K1 t.b.l. (through back loop) into same st). There are 57 sts. Shape top as follows:
19th row: (RS of work) K3, (K2tog, K8) 5 times, K2tog, K2 (6 decs made). **20th row:** P to end. **21st row:** K, dec 6 sts above previous decs. **22nd row:** P to end. From **23rd and 26th row:** rep last 2 rows twice: 33 sts remain. **27th row:** * K3 tog; rep to end. 11 sts rem. **28th row:** P1, (p2tog) 5 times: 6 sts remain. Do not cast off. Cut yarn leaving a long end. Leave rem 6 sts on the needle.

INSTRUCTIONS SCARF

With 9mm needles cast on 25 sts and, for border, work 8 rows K1, P1 rib, corresponding to 6cm, and cont in st st, working 1 selvedge st at each end in garter st. When Scarf measures 166cm from beg, work 8 rows K1, P1 rib for border, corresponding to 6cm, then cast off.
