



Measurements:

41cm wide
200cm long

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: 7 hanks
(each hank 100g and 70m)
of **Slalom** yarn (100% Virgin
Wool SW), shade no. 31407

Needles: A pair of 12.00mm
needles

Sewing needle: Yarn
needle with rounded point

Other item: A crochet hook for knotting fringes

STITCHES

Using needles: Stocking stitch (st st)

TENSION

9½ stitches measure approx 10cm width over stocking st using 12.00 mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

With 12mm needles cast on 40 sts and work in st st. AT THE SAME TIME, create decorative chained edges as follow: **RS row:** slip 1st st and 2nd sts knitways onto right needle, K rem 38 sts to end. **WS row:** with yarn in front, slip 1st st and 2nd sts purlways onto right needle, P rem 38 sts to end. When Scarf measures 200cm from beg, cast off evenly all sts.

Fringes: complete Scarf knotting 8 fringes along each short edge (cast on row and cast off row). For each fringe, cut 2 strands approximately 25cm long. Holding the strands together, fold in half, insert your crochet hook through the first st on lower edge of Scarf, hook the strands through the st and pull up a loop. Thread the loose ends through the loop and pull tight. Repeat this process along lower edge every 4/5 sts approx and knot 8th fringe to last st. Then knot other 8 fringes in the same manner along upper edge of Scarf. Lay out on a flat surface and trim the fringes to neaten up.
